


## We need volunteers

### Who we are

Did you know that Catterick, Richmond and Colburn libraries are managed by the community? We are a group of volunteers who came together in 2016 to help keep our libraries open. We are a registered charity (No. 1171181) and are managed by a group of volunteer-trustees. We took over the running of the library in April 2017 in partnership with North Yorkshire County Council.

### Library Volunteers

Volunteers work in teams of two for shifts of up to four hours, including a tea break. This means volunteers can work alongside friends or make new ones. A member of staff is often present to provide on-the-job training and support. We hope you will commit to weekly or fortnightly shifts, but there is a lot of flexibility. Don't worry if you have no IT experience because we can work around this.

### Behind the Scenes

We also need people to help us in behind-the-scenes roles – people with skills in fund-raising, marketing, administration, social media, managing events, IT and more. If you have skills in these areas we would love to hear from you.




## Make a difference in your community

### Training for Volunteers

All our volunteers receive training and help from professional staff. We also encourage new volunteers to shadow experienced volunteers as nothing works better than learning on the job. Each library has a Volunteer Coordinator and Lead Trustee to look after volunteers. From time to time volunteers receive training in new developments to keep them up-to-date. We also hold special events to thank volunteers for their support.

### Interested in helping with events or management?

We have a group of trustees who manage the library and make decisions, as well as volunteers who plan events. We always need helpers – tea-makers, cake-makers, bunting makers, raffle-ticket sellers, meet-and-greeters – the list goes on.


